The Rocks District of Milton-Freewater is a 6 square mile sub-appellation of the Walla Walla Valley that resides entirely on the Oregon side of the valley. The Rocks District is named for an ancient deposit of river cobblestones on top of which some of the most fascinating Syrah vines on the planet grow. This wine hails from two esteemed vineyards: Stoney Vine and Stones Speak. Rocks Syrah is earthy, meaty, and spicy. We call it “The Funk.” And in this case, the funk is beautiful.
